Overview of product

With most workshop visits requiring some form of diagnostics, the compact KTS 350 is the latest product from Bosch to help technicians quickly and easily diagnose vehicle faults, and walk them through the repair. Providing an efficient and comprehensive solution for control unit diagnosis, maintenance, troubleshooting and repair, the all-in-one tool ensures a quick, professional fix, saving the technician not only time but also saving the business money.

With a fast boot up time of 45 seconds and ESI[tronic] 2.0 software already installed and configured, the tool is ready to use and this quick start ultimately saves time during each repair or service. The more powerful processor, four gigabytes of RAM and a quick 256-gigabytes SSD program memory, combined with the current Windows 10 operating system, ensure fast working.

Parallel channel communication allows communication to more than one CAN system simultaneously, further facilitating a quick repair. It also allows the tool to perform PassThru, the ability to enter an OEM portal and access updates required for the vehicle. Further reducing upload times, the KTS 350 also has Diagnostics over Internet Protocol (DoIP) capability, which works 200 times faster than high speed CAN, improving efficiency for workshops and helping get to a fix even more quickly.

What it does

Ideal for independent workshops due to its portable nature, the pre-installed ESI[tronic] 2.0 software along with the tablet and communication module provide an efficient overall package for professional repairs and maintenance of vehicles.

The PassThru interface grants access to the online portals of vehicle manufacturers, already supported by leading brands, and the user is guided through the repair and maintenance process. Up to date information and expertise from the manufacturer including ECU programming downloads, are available to support the job.

This latest Bosch diagnostic tool is part of a range of products, that also includes the KTS 560 and KTS 590, designed to help technicians diagnose

vehicle faults as quickly and easily as possible. ESI[tronic] 2.0 software provides intelligent troubleshooting, walking the user through the diagnosis and repair according to the manufacturer's specification. All relevant information for the vehicle is provided, with downloadable updates available as new information becomes available.
